Advantis Credit Union to Open New Branch in Woodstock Neighborhood

Portland, ORE., Jan. 3, 2017 — Advantis Credit Union, one of Oregon’s largest not-for-profit financial cooperatives will open a full-service branch in the Woodstock neighborhood of Southeast Portland in the summer of 2017. The branch will be located at 4235 SE Woodstock Boulevard.

Since its founding in 1928, Portland-based Advantis has been dedicated to serving its members and being an active community partner. As a non-for-profit member owned financial cooperative, the credit union returns earnings in the form of better rates, lower fees, and more free services. In 2015, Advantis contributed nearly \$200,000 to local organizations through grants and sponsorships and volunteered more than 700 service hours through its staff volunteer programs.

The Woodstock branch will be located in a well-known building in the heart of the Woodstock neighborhood: the former location of Beckwith Cycle, most recently the Bike Gallery. “Our family celebrates Advantis stepping into the Woodstock corridor because of their demonstrated commitment to community engagement,” said Deborah Beckwith Peterson. “We believe Advantis will continue to honor the legacy of our father, Frank L. Beckwith, with their participation in Woodstock’s community events and through the services they provide to our neighbors.”

When it opens in the summer of 2017, the new branch will provide a full range of financial services, from checking, savings and CDs to home mortgages, retirement planning, consumer and business loans.
